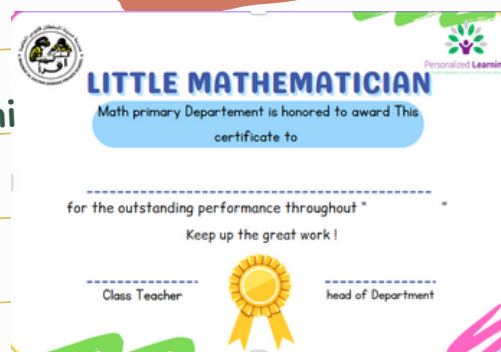

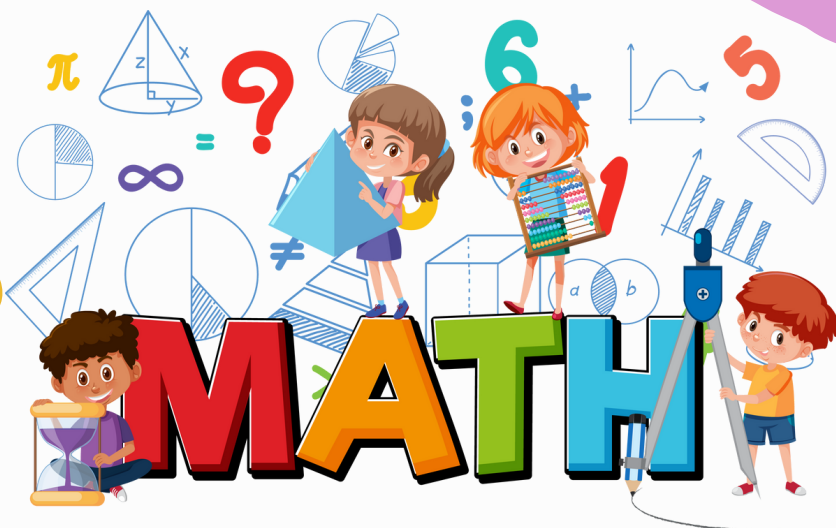

Guess the number by revealing the clues on the clouds one by one. This will help the children to know about the number properties of a two-digit number.

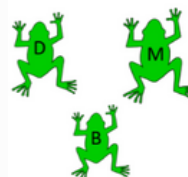

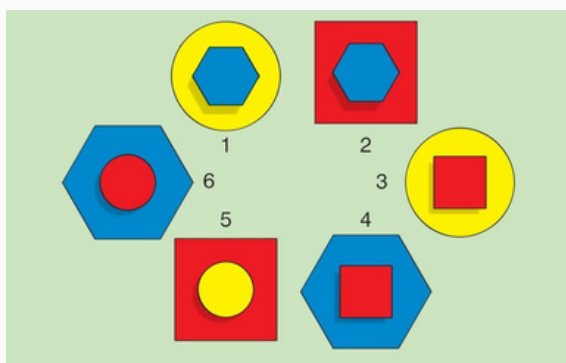
CAPTAIN SALAMANDER CHALLENGE

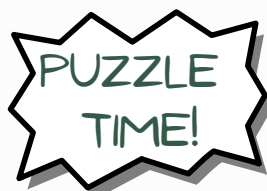


Dorris and Borris weigh 12g altogether

How much does each frog weigh?

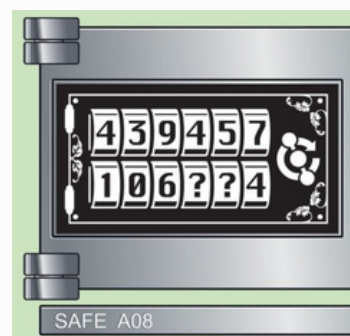

What has your child been doing this month in Math?

Grade 1	Students enjoyed learning about 3D and 2D shapes and they had lots of hands on activities

Grade 5	Square and Triangular Numbers, Prime and Composite Numbers, Mode and Median, Adding and Subtracting Including Decimals, Adding and subtracting Positive and Negative numbers
Grade 6	Mode, Median, Mean and Range, Positive and Negative Numbers, Using Letters to Represent Numbers, Quadrilaterals, Circle, Rotational Symmetry
