Guess the number by revealing the clues on the clouds one by one. This will help the children to know about the number properties of a two-digit number.




CAPTAIN SALAMANDER CHALLENGE


Dorris and Borris weigh 12g altogether Borris and Morris weigh 16g altogether Borris and Morris weigh 14g altogether How much does each frog weigh?


